NAME

Alpine crossing in the presence of the Mulaz and Focobon brothers

DIFFICULTY

Easy

DESCRIPTION

An incredible high-altitude journey within everyone's reach. Among ridges, lakes, scree, alpine meadows, forests and huts, our heart will beat faster admiring the imposing walls first of Monte Mulaz and then of the 3 peaks Zopel, Campido and Focobon (from which the group takes its name). A perspective towards Falcade and the Val del Biois from a truly 'local' and privileged point of view.

PATH

We will start from Passo Valles, along the path of the Alta via n. 2 towards Lake Caladora. Still in the direction of Mulaz we will continue on the path that touches the Passo di Venegiota up to the Fochet. Having completed this part of the route on the ridge characterized by affordable ups and downs, we will begin our descent towards the stream and the Focobon valley passing through the homonymous dairy. We will leave the rocky amphitheater behind us to enter the forest which will calmly accompany us towards the village of Molino and the end of our route (in the morning we will leave some cars here and then pick up the others at Passo Valles).

LOGISTICS

- The meeting is scheduled for 9:00 in the parking lot of the Falcade playground area. (address/position visible on the map to the side).
- We will drive for a few minutes to the parking lot near the Eden campsite where we will leave some cars (end point of our excursion). With the remaining cars we will then reach the starting point of our excursion by going up to Passo Valles (about 15 minutes away).
- At the end of the excursion we will recover the cars left at the starting point in Passo Valles.
- The meeting time may vary according to the weather forecast for that day. Any changes in the program will be communicated to the participants in time.

NOTES

- To undertake this excursion, it is necessary to have previously completed routes of similar length and difference in height.
- Along the way there are some narrower and more exposed sections of the path. This excursion is recommended for those who do not suffer from vertigo.
- The age of participation is suggested and indicative, any special requests for younger ages (via the booking form) motivated by adequate previous experience in the mountains will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
- There are no refuges along the route. A packed lunch is therefore necessary.
- Reservations are accepted until 16:00 on the day before the excursion.
- The cost is per person. Payment can be made on the spot on the day of the excursion (in cash), or by bank transfer in the days preceding the excursion (the IBAN details will be communicated via the booking confirmation email). In case of bad weather (or physical impossibility of the guide) which prevents the excursion from taking place, the entire cost will be refunded and the excursion rescheduled where possible.
- The cost of participation is related to the guide service on excursions with Accompagnatore di Media Montagna.
- Appropriate equipment and clothes are required for the type of excursion and time of year. The following are required: mountain boots, sufficiently large backpack, rainproof layers, cap/hat, water bottle, packed lunch, sunscreen. Recommended: warmer layers of clothing, spare clothing, sticks, snacks, sunglasses. People who show up at the start without required material will be excluded for safety reasons; no refund will therefore be due.
- Considering the period of the year and still the possible presence of snow due to late perturbations, the itinerary of the excursion could undergo forced variations (or cancellation communicated in time).
